## SPARKLING/WHITE/ROSÉ

33003	Champagne Guy Larmandier 1er Cru à Vertus	NV	85
	Elegant Champagne based on Chardonnay from the village of Vertus in the southern Cote des Blancs. A touch of Pinot Noir lends fruit, but the focus remains on freshness and levity.		
33015	Champagne Roger Coulon <i>Reserve de l'Hommeé</i>	NV	90
	Now on their eighth generation of winemakers, Eric and Isabelle Coulon continue to produce exceptional wine from Vrgny in the Montagne de Reims. This wine is a blend of equal parts Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay. The Chardonnay spends about half a year in barrel lending richness and texture to this Champagne, resulting in a fuller-bodied style.		
33048	Champagne Henri Giraud <i>L'Esprit</i>	NV	100
	The Giraud estate is probably best known for their intensely vinous and oak-driven bold Champagne from the Grand Cru Aÿ. The Esprit blend showcases the house style in a more affordable and less stern package. The Pinot Noir here expresses its pedigree with a fresher touch while maintaining intensity.		
33050	Champagne Minière F&R <i>Influence</i>	2007	110
	Aged six years before release, this vintage Champagne showcases maturity on the palate with an emphasis on the fermentation and maturation in barrel. The 40 year old vines are older than many in Champagne, providing low yields of extraordinary fruit. The resulting wine is golden in color and boldly flavored, but maintains a defined minerality. Only 3,000 bottles were produced for the 2007 vintage of this label.		
33035	Champagne Ruppert-Leroy <i>Saignée des Cognaux</i>	2011	125
	The spirit of Gerard Ruppert and his daughter Benedicte Leroy is immediately apparent in this Champagne. Coming from biodynamically-farmed vineyards in the Aube, this is a rosé expression of 100% Pinot Noir made in a brut nature style. Finely dry with an exotic, floral aroma and a wild, savory edge, this wine evokes the idea of "Burgundy with bubbles."		
17802	Casa d'Ambra Biancolella/Forestera <i>Ischia</i>	2015	40
	Low in alcohol and high in acid, this wine screams of its island identity. Crisp, vibrant and refreshing, this wine allows all kinds of light dishes to shine while adding just the right dash of pithy citrus flavors to keep you wanting more.		
18810	Ayunta Etna Bianco <i>Piante/Sparse, Sicily</i>	2014	65
	This wine is definitely a project of love rather than ease. Everything is done by hand and the wines are made in a non-interventionalist way. The vines for this wine are scattered throughout the red grape vines, so its a time consuming and laborious process to seek out and harvest the white grapes. The resulting wine is worth the effort though, showcasing the sheer minerality of Carricante with a ripeness of fruit uncommon in Etna. The mixed plantings mean they aren't 100% sure what else accompanies Carricante, but that just adds to the fun.		
17810	Mastroberardino Fiano di Avellino <i>Radici, Campania</i>	2006	60
	Although best known for profound expressions of Aglianico from Taurasi, Mastroberardino also makes compelling white wine. Fiano is a grape that truly translates the sense of place; one can imagine walking the foothills of Mount Vesuvius when they encounter the varity's natural smokiness. There is a veneer of oxidation and maturity from 10 years of age that enhances the overall savory experience of the wine.		
11612	Rodrigo Mendez Albariño <i>Salvora, Rías Baixas</i>	2014	90
	Fuller-bodied Albariño than some may be used to. The wine is aged in old barrels, not to add oak flavors of vanilla and spice, but to add richness to the mouthfeel. Ultimately, the persistent citrus and saline character natural to the grape shine through, but they do so backed by a rounder, more complete wine.		
14028	Ronco Severo Friulano <i>Friuli</i>	2014	70
	Ronco Severo is the playful expression of grapes native to Friuli made by Stefano Novello. This wine does see a little bit of skin contact, but not as much as some of the more rustic and earthy expressions from the region. The light touch of skin contact allows floral and pleasatnly almond-toned flavor of Friulano to shine through.		
14014	Luis Rodriguez Vasquez Treixadura/Albariño/Torrontes <i>Os Pasas, Ribeiro</i>	2013	70
	Medium bodied white wine with succulent orchard and stone fruit flavors up front that develop into citrus blossom and sea breeze. The splash of Torrontes gives a pretty floral accent without becoming too perfumed and the Albariño lends a refreshing salty tang to the finish.

**SOMMELIER PICKS (select a wine for a brief description)**

## RED WINE

- 13032 Montevertine Sangiovese *Pian del Ciampolo, Tuscany* 2014 70  
Coming from younger vines and with a splash of Colorino/Canaiolo, this wine from Montevertine is a lively, vibrant expression of Sangiovese. Packed with crunchy, tart red fruit flavors, this wine is the perfect medium-bodied companion to any Italian meal.
- 11205 G.B Burlotto Verduno Pelaverga *Piedmont* 2015 50  
Pelaverga is an oft-overlooked grape of the Piedmont region that offers something unique and different. The wine is medium bodied and dark-fruited but quite savory, spicy, and lightly smoky. It finishes quite fresh though, making it perfect for happy sipping and eating.
- 18004 Ayunta Etna Rosso *Navigable, Sicily* 2013 65  
I love Nerello Mascalese for its pure expression of provenance. The wines of Mount Etna have such an amazing undercurrent of volcanic flavors that the whimsy of wine descriptors make real concrete sense. The structure is reminiscent of Burgundy, making you uncertain to call the wine light or not. Either way, it's delicious!
- 18006 Escalado do Sil *Valdeorras* 2014 85  
This wine is made from Merenzao (Trousseau, Mencia and Grenache vinified with whole cluster fermentation and aged in medium sized barrels. The resulting wine is deft on its feet and able to go head to head with Pinot Noir in a contest for finesse.
- 16506 Marinushof Zweigelt *Alto Adige* 2015 80  
Dark fruited and juicy, this wine drinks a bit like Syrah without so much austerity and tannin. One might also draw similarities to Cru Beaujolais, but with a slightly plummier fruit flavor.
- 18021 Gulfi Cerasuolo di Vittoria *Sicily* 2015 60  
I normally don't like Cerasuolo because I find Frappato can ruin perfectly good Nero d'Avola. However, this is one of the best, balanced examples I have found. The dark fruit of Nero d'Avola takes the foreground with just the right amount of playful brightness to make this an excellent Cerasuolo di Vittoria.
- 29009 Balgera Valtellina Superiore *Ca'Fracia, Lombardia* 2000 90  
This wine offers Nebbiolo made is a much lighter, less tannic style than what one encounters in Barolo or Barbaresco. The wine is soft, red fruited, lightly herbal and floral, and a really beautiful expression of Nebbiolo.
- 18002 Raul Perez Mencia *Ultreia St. Jacques, Bierzo* 2013 70  
Mencia has quickly become one of my favorite grapes. To me it can be a real shapeshifter: sometimes it tastes like Pinot Noir, sometimes like Syrah. This expression sees whole clusters in the fermentation and is matured in large barrels. The resulting wine is floral, elegant, and lively, framing the dark fruit of Mencia with the lift and polish of Burgundy.
- 29005 Arturo Pelizzatti Valtellina *Grumello, Lombardia* 1969 180  
This is the wine before Ar.Pe.Pe was formed. Delicate, autumnal, but still properly structured, this wine is an amazing window into why Nebbiolo is considered one of the most ageworthy Italian red grapes.
- 15016 Giuseppe Quintarelli Valpolicella Classico Superiore *Veneto* 2008 165  
The late Giuseppe Quintarelli made some of the Veneto's finest, most memorable examples of Valpolicella and Amarone. His style moves away from the dense, sometimes syrupy style that can result from the drying of fruit, and remains true to expressing beautiful ripeness without forgetting the importance of finesse. His wines showcase dark red fruits, but have a unique green, slightly vegetative character that provide definition and structure in a very pleasing way.
- 10038 Bruno Giacosa Barolo *Azienda Agricola Falletto, Piedmont* 2001 190  
The wines of Bruno Giacosa express the exceptional power of Nebbiolo from Serralunga d'Alba. While medium-bodied, the tension provided by the tannin and minerality of the wine provide context for what makes Barolo so great. This wine exemplifies the aromas of truffle and rose that many seek from high-quality Barolo.
- 10060 Giacomo Conterno Barolo *Cascina Francia, Piedmont* 2001 250  
A wine that is right in the middle of its age trajectory. The wine expresses the warmth of the vintage with deep, generous red fruit but has a brooding earthiness, only beginning to hint at its 15 years of maturity.
- 10500 Ca' Marcanda - Angelo Gaja *Promis, Tuscany* 2000 170  
The Ca' Marcanda estate was Angelo Gaja's venture into Super Tuscan wine making. While the Promis bottling is often encountered youthful and fresh, it has wonderful potential to mature into a fantastic expression of Merlot, Syrah, and Sangiovese. Dark, early, loamy fruits have a backbone of spice from the Syrah and the Sangiovese
